

REASONS FOR REFUSAL

OF APPLICATION: 4/1228/92

Date of Decision: 12.11.1992



REFUSED for the following reason:

- The retention of the existing housing stock is an integral part of the approved housing strategy of the Development Plan, policies of which aim to safeguard this stock. The proposal results in the loss of residential accommodation and therefore prejudices this strategy in the local centre. Residential properties should be retained in order to maintain the mix of uses in the Old Town Local Centre.
- The use of the premises may be detrimental to the amenities of local residents.
- There is no provision for vehicle parking within the site to meet standards adopted by the local planning authority.
