4/1229/84G. DEEP FREEZE CUBICLE.
NATURAL HISTORY MUSEUM, AKEMAN STREET, TRING.
APPLICANT: DEPARTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENT

DESCRIPTION - The proposed building measures 3.5 m by 4.5 m and is 2.8 m high, with a flat roof. It is to be located on the east side of the site, but will be surrounded on all sides by existing buildings.

POLICIES

REPRESENTATIONS

Tring Town Council : Recommend approval

CONSIDERATIONS - The proposed development is to be carried out by the Department of the Environment on Crown land, and no planning permission is therefore required. However, the Department has notified the Council under the procedures set out in DoE Circular 18/84, in order that the Council may comment on the proposals. The deep freezer building will not be visible from outside the Museum complex and will not have any impact on the Conservation Area.

✓ RECOMMENDATION - That the Department of the Environment be informed that the Council has no objections to the proposed deep freeze cubicle.
