The removal of the five trees would detract greatly from the visual amenity of the area. In particular:

- 1. The fir tree is fully mature and would appear to be quite unobtrusive.
- 2. The crowns of the sycamore tree and lime trees in line are quite dense however this could be overcome by judicious pruning.
- 3. The sycamore standing on its own is not at this moment in time a problem in terms of safety or amenity.
- 4. The trees are in good health and are not any more susceptible to wind throw than trees of similar species and size.
