- 1. The proposed extension of 1 Shendish Edge and its conversion to two flats is excessive on a site which is inadequate satisfactorily to accommodate the proposal together with the necessary amenities and vehicle parking facilities.
- 2. The proposed boundary walls would prove severely injurious to the general character and amenity of the area and would be detrimental to the amenity of the occupants of the Lodge.
- 3. The location of the proposed walls on the south side of the drive to Shendish House would obstruct the existing driveway to Shendish Lodge rendering this access unsatisfactory and giving rise to conditions prejudicial to highway safety.
