In order to give greater security to the electricity supply to the Hazel Hempstead, Berkhamssted, Chestam and Ameraham areas it is necessary to erect a 33,000 volt overhead line to be supported on wooden poles from Piccotts End to Lye Green which is shown on the enclosed Drawing Numbers HA2/981/MP1 Issue A, HA2/982/MP2 Issue A, HA3/982/MP3 Issue C, HA2/982/MP4 Issue B and HA0/982/MP5 Issue A by thick black continuous lines subject to a reasonable deviation as may be found necessary such deviation not to exceed 50 metres on either side.


