Tree Preservation Order No 3 1966, Box Lane.

Remove 3 dead Beech and 1 dying Spruce tree in W1 rear of 3 Haywood Drive, Hemel Hempstead.

- 1. That 4 replacement trees shall be planted in the first planting season following removal of the existing trees.
- 2. Replacement to be selected from the following list of species:
 - (a) Common Beech (Fagus Sylvatica)
 - (b) Ash (Fraximus excelsior)
 - (c) Wild Cherry (Prunus avium)
- 3. Replacements shall be light standards in size; ie at least 6-8 cms girth at 1 m above ground level and 2.5 to 2.75 m overall height and shall be planted in the vicinity of the trees to be removed.
- 4. The Council must be notified when the replacement trees have been planted so that an inspection can be carried out.

REASONS:

The trees to be removed are dead or dying.
