ENFORCEMENT NOTICE (OPERATIONAL DEVELOPMENT)

ISSUED BY: DACORUM BOROUGH COUNCIL

1. THIS IS A FORMAL NOTICE which is issued by the Council because it appears to them that there has been a breach of planning control, under section 171A(1)(a) of the above Act, at the land described below. They consider that it is expedient to issue this notice, having regard to the provisions of the development plan and to other material planning considerations.

2. THE LAND AFFECTED

Land at Comusbury High Street Green Hemel Hempstead Hertfordshire shown edged red on the attached plan.

3. THE BREACH OF PLANNING CONTROL ALLEGED

Without planning permission, the raising of the rear garden over its total length to a depth of 1.75 metres by depositing materials and earth.

4. REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE

It appears to the Council that the above breach of planning control has occurred within the last four years.

The increase in the ground level of the garden results in overlooking and loss of privacy to the occupants of the adjacent houses.

The Council do not consider that the development could be made acceptable by the imposition of conditions on a planning permission. If fences were erected to counter the effect of the raised garden and to prevent any overlooking then the fences would need to be of such height as to be overbearing and intrusive in themselves.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

- (i) Remove the materials and earth which have been deposited in the rear garden.
- (ii) Regrade the rear garden to its former level.

Time for compliance: 3 months after this notice takes effect.

6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 3rd August 1902—unless an appeal is made against it beforehand.



On conviction, a fine of up to £20,000 may be imposed by the Magistrates' Court or an unlimited fine by the Crown Court.
