- 1. The site is within the Metropolitan Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum District Plan wherein permission will only be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agricultural or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participatory sport or recreation. No evidence has been provided to demonstrate the need for the proposed agricultural building on such a small holding of 1 ha and the proposed development is unacceptable in the terms of this policy.
- 2. The adopted Dacorum District Plan shows the site to be within the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty wherein the policy of the local planning authority seeks to preserve the appearance of the area, encourage agriculture and conserve wildlife by the restriction of further development, having particular regard to the siting, design and external appearance of buildings. The proposed agricultural building would be a large and imposing structure in an isolated position in a very sensitive location. Such a building would, if permitted, prove severely injurious to the character and amenity of the surrounding open countryside.
