The adopted Dacorum District Plan shows the site to be within the Metropolitan Green Belt wherein permission will only be given for use of land, construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agricultural or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participating sport or recreation. The proposed use would result in the erection of buildings and the construction of large parking areas on open land in a very sensitive and vulnerable location between Kings Langley and Hemel Hempstead and, if permitted, would prove severely injurious to the character and amenity of the surrounding area.
