**1. The work hereby authorised shall be completed within two years of the date of the decision notice.**

Reason: To ensure that any change in circumstances or in the condition of the tree[s] is taken into account.

**2. Notwithstanding the details of the proposed work set out in the letter from T.H.T. dated 8 August 1999 received by the local planning authority on 11 August 1999, this consent authorises only the following works:**

- (a) Beech Tree T1 - Fell;
- (b) Beech Tree T2 - Lifting of the crown by a maximum of 6 m above ground level;
- (c) Lime Tree T3 - Lifting of the crown by a maximum of 6 m above ground level;
- (d) Lime Tree T4 - Lifting of the crown by a maximum of 6 m above ground level.

Reasons:

- (a) For the avoidance of doubt.
- (b) The proposed thinning to the Beech T2 tree as specified by the letter from T.H.T Services dated 8 August 1999 is not acceptable because it would be detrimental to the health of the tree and is not considered necessary. Only the works specified in part (b) of this condition are authorised.

**3. All work shall be carried out in accordance with B.S.3998:1989 "Recommendations for tree work".**

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory standard of tree work.

INFORMATIVE:

The conifer hedge is not subject to Tree Preservation Order No.3 (1966).
