- 1. The proposal constitutes an overdevelopment of the site resulting in insufficient amenity space for Brig End.
- 2. Policy 107 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan requires development to make a positive contribution to the environment of the canalside. The proposal would result in development within 2m of the Grand Union Canal, resulting in an unacceptable loss of open land adjacent to the Canal.
- 3. The proposal results in development which would obstruct Berkhamsted Footpath No.3. This loss of footpath is unacceptable and contrary to Policy 74 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan which aims to protect, improve and promote the public footpath network.
