4. The windows in the converted barn and link hereby authorised shall be of a white painted galvanised steel 'Crittal' style to match the existing windows found in the listed building.

5. No works shall commence until details of the doors to be inserted in both the converted barn and link hereby authorised shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority

6. The flue located in the northeast elevation of the barn subject to this application shall be constructed of metal and finished matt black, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the local planning authority.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building

7. No works shall take place until details of the mortar mix to be used in the link hereby authorised shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building.
