Your application dated *15 September 1979* was received
on *2 October 1979*

Examination of the forms of application and accompanying plans and documents to ascertain whether your application complies with the statutory requirements has not been completed.

If on further examination, it is found that the application is invalid for failure to comply with such requirements (or for any other reason) a further communication will be sent to you as soon as possible.

If by *26 November 1979* you have not received notification that your application is invalid and the authority dealing with your application have not given you notice of their decision (and you have not agreed with them in writing that the period within which their decision shall be given may be extended) you may appeal to the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 36 and 37 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 by notice sent within six months from that date (unless the application has already been referred by this authority to the Secretary of State for the Environment). Appeals must be made on a form which is obtainable from the Department of the Environment.
