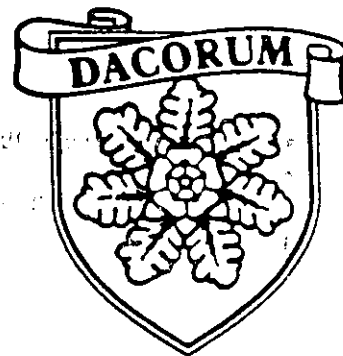

Only the following work to the 6 Horse Chestnuts shall be carried out to British Standard 3998 (1989) Recommendations for Tree Work:

Shorten back lateral branches extending over roof of house by maximum of 2 metres.

Shorten back lateral branches extending over paddock by a maximum of 4 metres to balance crowns. Branches should be cut at a suitable side branch to maintain the natural shape of the trees.

Selectively thin crowns by a maximum of 20% including deadwood, snags or crossing branches.

Lift crowns by a maximum of 4 metres on the paddock side. No cuts to be made on the main trunk.

Reason: The works will alleviate light restriction and nuisance to the property and will not detract significantly from the amenity value of the trees.
