

REASONS FOR REFUSAL

OF APPLICATION: 4/1473/95

1. The site is within the Metropolitan Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan wherein permission will only be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agricultural or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participatory sport or recreation. No such need has been proven and the proposed development is unacceptable and inappropriate in the terms of this policy.

2. The site is within the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty wherein the primary planning objective is the preservation of the natural beauty of the area. The proposed extension of residential curtilage onto agricultural land is incompatible with this policy, and would cause harm to the natural beauty and amenity of the area.
