APPLICANT: HM PRISON SERVICE

[Case Officer: Paul Newton]

<u>DESCRIPTION</u> - The application site forms part of The Mount Prison which is sited off Chesham Road on the outskirts of Bovingdon.

The proposal involves the construction of an external oil tank compound and concrete bund. The compound is to be sited adjacent to the existing boiler house close to the entrance of the prison site.

## **REPRESENTATIONS**

**Bovingdon Parish Council** 

It is recommended that planting be undertaken as stated in (2) of the application letter to Dacorum Borough Council dated 18 November, and brick facing as stated in (3).

Note: The application letter states:

- "1. You will note that there is an intention to demolish and reconstruct a section of the existing brick wall at the south-west corner of the boiler house yard. The new section of wall will be neatly bonded into and match the existing wall in all respects.
- Part of the screen planting on the opposite side of the wall which is to be reconstructed will inevitably be removed. The planting principally comprises Hawthorn, Ash, Willow, Wild Cherry and a mixture of shrubs. I should be pleased to know whether you would recommend reinstating the lost portion of planting, which could probably be positioned close to the existing planting.
- 3. The walls of the proposed tank bund will be of concrete construction, extending to a height of 1.3 m above ground level. Once again, I should welcome your views with regard to the external treatment for the concrete bund walls and whether for instance ...."

## Civil Aviation Authority

No objection.

<u>CONSIDERATIONS</u> - The application is submitted in accordance with the consultation procedure laid down in Circular 18/84.

The proposal is of a minor nature and is sited within the confines of the prison grounds. It is considered that provided existing planting is replaced, the proposal will not significantly harm the objectives of Green Belt policy.

RECOMMENDATION - That the HM Prison Service be informed that subject to the reinstatement of planting around the compound and the use of brick facing around the concrete bund, the Borough Council has no objections to the proposal.
