- 1. Only the following works shall be carried out to the trees in W1, as identified on the accompanying plan:
 - (a) T1 (Cherry) fell
 - (b) T2 (Cherry) fell
 - (c) T4 (Ash) fell
 - (d) T5 (Norway Maple) crown lift to a height of 2 m and remove major deadwood
 - (e) T6 (Ash) crown lift to 4 m and remove major deadwood
 - (f) T7 (Horse Chestnut) fell
 - (g) T8 (Horse Chestnut) reshape crown to improve structure of the tree
 - (h) T9 (Cherry) remove major deadwood and split limb
 - (i) T10 (Ash) remove major deadwood and crown lift to 2 m
 - (j) T11 (Cherry) remove major deadwood
 - (k) T12 (Cherry) fell
 - (1) T13 (Cherry) fell
 - (m) T14 (Oak) remove major deadwood
 - (n) T15 (Chestnut) clean out lower crown, broken stubs, crossing branches
 - (o) T16 (Oak) remove major deadwood
 - (p) T18 (Aspen) reshape and crown thin by 25%, crown lift by 4 m
 - (q) T19 (Aspen) fell
 - (r) T21 (Aspen) fell
 - (s) Four poplars in the shelterbelt adjacent to Bunkers Lane (numbered 1-4 on the plan) fell
 - (t) Two aspens in the shelterbelt adjacent to Bunkers Lane (numbered 2 and 3 on the plan) fell.

 \underline{Reason} : The trees are poor specimens, unsuitable species for their position or have little amenity value.

2. All works shall be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998.

Reason: To ensure proper standards of treework are maintained.

- The replacements for the felled trees shall be planted in years 2 and 3 of the Management Plan.
 - (a) Year 2 the species planted shall be:

Pinus sylvestris x 3 Acer campcotre x 2 Pinus nigra var maritima x 2 Sorbus torminalis x 1

(b) Year 3 - the species planted shall be:

Sorbus aucuparia 'Asplenifolia' x 2 Malus sylvestris x 1 Pinus nigra var maritima x 2

(c) The replacements shall be light standards with a girth of between 6-8 cm, a clear stem height of 1.5 to 1.8 m from the ground to first branch and an overall height of between 2.5 to 2.75 m.

 $\underline{\text{Reason}}$: To maintain a woodland setting in keeping with the neighbouring woodland species, to encourage wildlife and enhance the woodland feel of the garden.
