FELLING AND REPLACEMENT OF PRESERVED TREE AND PRUNING PRESERVED TREE.

- The following works only may be carried out:
 - (a) Reduce holly in height by one third and prune side laterals to balance and reshape.
 - (b) Fell Sycamore.

<u>Reason</u>: Reducing holly will improve its appearance. Sycamore is a poor specimen and will grow too large for its location.

2. All work shall be carried out in accordance with British Standard 3998 (Recommendations for Tree Work).

Reason: To ensure an appropriate standard of tree work.

- 3. One replacement tree shall be planted in the first planting season following the felling of the sycamore tree. The replacement tree shall be a standard with a stem circumference of at least 8 cm measured 1 m from ground level and an overall height of 2.75 m. The tree shall be one of the following species:
 - (i) Robina pseudocacia (false acacia)
 - (ii) Gleditsia triacanthos 'Sunburst' (variegated honey locust)
 - (iii) Robina pseudoacacia 'Frisia' (variegated false acacia)

Reason: To perpetuate amenity and to ensure that the replacement is of an appropriate species.
