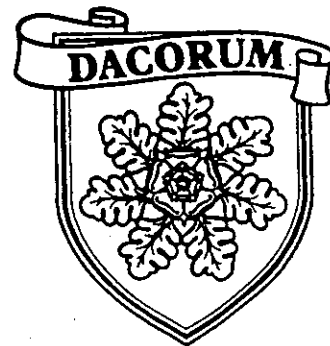

1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: To comply with the provisions of s.91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The materials used externally shall match both in colour and texture those on the existing building of which this development shall form a part.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

3. No work shall commence on the garage and garden store hereby permitted until protective fencing has been erected around the silver birch tree as indicated in green on drg no. 1586/06B. This protective fencing shall be as recommended in BS 5837 Trees and Construction and it shall remain in position until works on the garage are complete.

Reason: To safeguard the tree and ensure its survival during building works.
