1. This consent is granted for a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1992.

2. Any advertisements displayed, and any site used for the display of advertisements shall be maintained in a clean and tidy condition to the reasonable satisfaction of the local planning authority.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1992.

3. Any structure or hoarding erected or used principally for the purpose of displaying advertisements shall be maintained in a safe condition.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the provisions of the Town Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1992.

4. Where an advertisement is required under the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1992 to be removed, the removal shall be carried out to the reasonable satisfaction of the local planning authority.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the provisions of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1992.

replacement signs which are the subject of this consent are installed on the building. Signs B and D shall be installed with trough lighting, details of which shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority prior to installation.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of safeguarding the character and appearance of the Listed Building and for the avoidance of doubt.

8. The existing sign labelled as 'X' on the northern flank wall and the bracket labelled as 'Y' on the northern front gable of the building referred to on the drawing labelled Sheet 2 shall be removed before any of the signs which are the subject of this consent are installed.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of the character and appearance of the listed building and the immediate vicinity and for the avoidance of doubt.
