1. The proposed development would have a detrimental impact on the open character of the street scene and on the the visual amenity of the locality. Furthermore, and notwithstanding the fact that each application is dealt with on its own merits, if permitted, this proposal would set a precedent for similar applications in respect of other areas of landscaping in the vicinity, which the local planning authority would find increasingly difficult to resist and which, cumulatively, would be seriously detrimental to the amenities and character of the locality.
