. Only the following works shall be carried out, in accordance with B.S. 3998: 1989 Recommendations for Tree Work:

T1 - Birch: Fell. T2 - Oak: Fell. T3 - Ash: Fell.

T4 - Oak: Remove any deadwood, weak or crossing branches as necessary, and remove 3 lowest branches over mobile home.

T5 - Sycamore: Remove deadwood, weak or crossing branches as necessary.

Reason: In the case of T1, T2 and T3, these trees have been totally supressed by their larger neighbours. Removal will allow adjacent trees to develop properly. So far as T4 and T5 are concerned, pruning will allow more light into a wooded garden and improve residential amenity.
