1. The works for which this consent is granted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this consent.

Reason: To comply with section 18 of the Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

2. All exposed timbers shall be treated with a mixture of beeswax and turpentine.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

3. All new plaster shall be applied in three coats; the first to be 1 part lime putty to 3 parts sand; the second coat to be 1 part lime putty to 3 parts sand; the third coat to be 3 parts lime putty to 2 parts sand, or such other mix as may be agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

4. No mechanical or hand held tool work shall be undertaken on the exposed timbers unless full details of the works shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority. Any works shall be carried out fully in accordance with the approved details.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and to ensure a satisfactory appearance.
