DACORUM BOROUGH COUNCIL V. THORNBERRY BROTHERS (HOLDINGS) LIMITED

I refer to the above case which was heard at the Magistrates' Court on Wednesday, 21 May 1986.

The defendant was found guilty of six of the seven charges as follows:-

Guilty

No. 11 Akeman Street - demolition of part of the building and alteration in a manner affecting the architectural or historic interest thereof.

No. 12/12a Akeman Street - alteration of the building in a manner affecting its architectural or historic interest.

No. 13 Akeman Street - demolition of part of the building and alteration in a manner affecting its architectural or historic interest.

No. 14 Akeman Street - alteration in a manner affecting the architectural or historic interest.

Not Guilty & Dismissed

No. 12/12A Akeman Street - demolition of part of the building.

The defendant company was fined £200 in respect of each charge and was ordered to pay £100 towards the Council's costs. The total of £1,300 should be paid within 7 days.

~~PURPOSE OF REPORT~~

At the Committee's meeting on 7 November 1985 authority was given to take proceedings against the above-named company for offences under s.55 (1) of the Town & Country Planning Act 1971 in respect of certain works of demolition and alteration to Listed Buildings at 11, 12/12a, 13 and 14 Akeman Street, Tring.

The matter eventually came before Dacorum Magistrates' Court on 21 May. The defendant was found guilty of six charges under s.55 and was fined a total of £1,200 for the offences and ordered to pay costs of £100.
