

THE CATTLE MARKET SITE, TRING - J SAINSBURY PLC

We wish to submit a revised conservation area consent application in respect of the J Sainsbury plc proposals for the Cattle Market site in Tring. We also wish to withdraw the original conservation area consent application made in December 1995 (application reference 4/1571/95).

This application should be considered in the context of the revised outline planning application for a supermarket on the site (application reference no. 4/1631/95). The scheme has now been revised to exclude Forge Cottage and conservation area consent is therefore no longer sought for its demolition. The revised access arrangements require the relocation of the existing public toilets on the High Street frontage a short distance to the west. Conservation area consent is therefore now sought for the demolition of the existing public toilets. As before, conservation area consent is being sought for the demolition of the small storage shed at the eastern end of the Old Forge Car Park. The structures to be demolished within the conservation area are shown on enclosed Plan 2B.
