


REASONS FOR REFUSAL

1. Due to the difference in levels between the application site and the site of the adjacent residential property the proposed first floor rear extension would, by virtue of its height and bulk, be overbearing and detrimental to the amenity at present enjoyed by the occupant of the adjacent dwelling.

2. The submitted drawing fails to demonstrate that the site can accommodate adequately the proposed extensions together with the required number of spaces for vehicle parking to meet the standards adopted by the local planning authority.
