In pursuance of their powers under the above-mentioned Acts and the Orders and Regulations for the time being in force thereunder, the Council hereby permit the development proposed by you in your application dated 19.9.89 and received with sufficient particulars on 25.9.89 and shown on the plan(s) accompanying such application, subject to the following conditions:—

- (1) The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of 5 years commencing on the date of this notice.
- (2) No work shall be started on the development hereby permitted until details of materials to be used externally shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority and the development hereby permitted shall be carried out in the materials so approved.
- (3) No development shall take place until there has been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority a scheme of landscaping which shall include indications of all existing trees and hedgerows on the land and details of numbers, species and proposed planting location of all new trees, shrubs and hedgerows.

- (1) To comply with the requirements of Section 41 of the Town & Country Planning Act, 1971.
- (2) To ensure a satisfactory appearance.
- (3) To maintain and enhance visual amenity.
- (4) To maintain and enhance visual amenity.

(4) In certain circumstances, a claim may be made against the local planning authority for compensation, where permission is refused or granted subject to conditions by the Secretary of State on appeal or on a reference of the application to him. The circumstances in which such compensation is payable are set out in section 169 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.

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subject to the following conditions contd/

- (4) All planting, seeding or turfing comprised in the approved details of landscaping, shall be carried out in the first planting and seeding seasons following the occupation of the buildings or the completion of the development, whichever is the sooner; and any trees or plants which within a period of 5 years from the completion of the development die, are removed or become seriously damaged or diseased shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of similar size and species, unless the local planning authority gives written consent to any variation, and for the purposes of this condition a planting season shall be deemed to commence in any one year on 1 October and to end on 31 March in the next following year.
- (5) The developer shall construct the crossover to Standards set out in the current edition of Hertfordshire County Council's "Specification for the Construction of Residential Estate Roads" and the development shall not be brought into use until the access is so constructed.
- (6) The development hereby permitted shall not be brought into use until the existing access has been closed and the kerbs and footway/verge reinstated to the standards set out in the current edition of Hertfordshire County Council's "Specification for the Construction of Residential Estates Roads".
