3. The use hereby permitted shall not commence until a scheme of sound insulation between the premises and the first floor flat has been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority; all works which form part of the scheme shall be completed before any part of the restaurant is brought into use.

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of adjoining residents.

4. The use hereby permitted shall not be commenced until there has been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority a scheme for ventilation of the premises, including the extraction and filtration of cooking fumes. The approved scheme shall be carried out prior to the commencement of the use hereby permitted.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of the amenity of adjoining residents.

5. The premises shall only be open to customers between the hours of 11.00 am and 11.00 pm on Mondays to Saturdays, and between 12.00 noon and 10.30 pm on Sundays, Bank Holidays and Public Holidays.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of the amenities of the occupants of neighbouring dwellings.
