- Only the following works shall be carried out and in accordance with British Standard 3998 Recommendations for Tree Work:
  - a) Trees 180, 189, 154, 152 and T2 fell
  - b) Tree 153 remove any deadwood, weak crossing or superfluous branches as necessary
  - remove all branch stubs
  - shorten back lateral branches extending towards neighbouring property by a maximum of 3 metres making all cuts to a suitable side branch or growing point.

Reason: The works are in the interests of good arboriculture, (the trees Nos 152, 154 and 189 are being supressed by their larger neighbour and have no long term future) and the alleviation of nuisance.

2. A replacement tree shall be planted following the removal of T2. The replacement shall be a Maidenhair tree - Ginkgo biloba, and shall measure between 1.8 m and 2.5 m high when planted. The tree shall be planted as close as practically possible to the existing tree position.

Reason: To maintain appropriate tree cover on site.
