1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: To comply with the provisions of s.91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The materials used externally shall match both in colour and texture those on the existing building of which this development shall form a part.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

3. The developer shall construct the crossover to standards set out in the current edition of Hertfordshire County Council's "Specification for the Construction of Residential Estate Roads" and the development shall not be brought into use until the access is so constructed.

Reason: In the interests of highways safety.

4. The proposed access shall not be brought into use until the existing access has been closed and the kerbs and footway/verge reinstated to the standards set out in the current edition of Hertfordshire County Council's "Specification for the Construction of Residential Estate Roads".

Reason: In the interests of highways safety.

5. A 2.4 m x 2.4 m visibility splay shall be provided each side of the access, measured from the edge of the accessway to the edge of the carriageway, within which there shall be no obstruction to visibility between 600 mm and 2.0 m above the carriageway level.

Reason: In the interests of highways safety.

6. Sight lines of 2.4 m  $\times$  2.4 m shall be provided in each direction within which there shall be no obstruction to visibility between 600 mm and 2.0 m above carriageway level.

Reason: In the interests of highways safety.
