- 1. The development to which this permission relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.
- 2. The materials used externally shall match both in colour and texture those on the existing building of which this development shall form a part.
- 3. The development hereby permitted, together with the remainder of the property of which it shall form a part shall be used only for domestic purposes as a single family dwelling.
- 4. The developer shall construct the crossover to standards set out in the current edition of Hertfordshire County Council's "Specification for the Construction of Residential Estate Roads" and the development shall not be brought into use until the access is so constructed.
- 5. A 2.4 m x 2.4 m visibility splay shall be provided each side of the access, measured from the edge of the accessway to the (edge of the carriageway) (back of the footway), within which there shall be no obstruction to visibility between 600 mm and 2.0 m above the (carriageway) (footway) level.
- 6. Sight lines of 2.4 x 35 m shall be provided in each direction within which there shall be no obstruction to visibility between 600 mm and 2.0 m above carriageway level.
