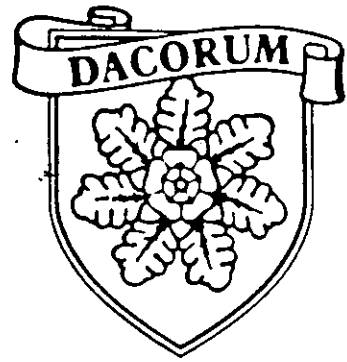

1. The works to which this consent relates shall be begun within a period of five years commencing on the date of this notice.

Reason: To comply with the provision of s.18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

2. No work shall be started on the development hereby permitted until details of materials to be used externally shall have been submitted to and approved by the local planning authority, and the development hereby permitted shall be carried out in the materials so approved.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

3. The mortar to the brickwork of the development hereby permitted shall be made up of one part lime putty to three parts well graded sharp sand (with a dash of cement) and finished with a rubbed flush joint.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory development.

4. The windows of the development hereby permitted shall be made up of individual lights set in traditional lead cames and shall not form part of a double glazed unit.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt.
