1. The external walls and roofs of the development hereby permitted shall be constructed and finished in accordance with a schedule of materials and finishes which shall be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority before development is commenced.

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory appearance.

2. No development shall take place until there has been submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority a fully detailed scheme of landscaping, which shall include indications of all existing trees and hedgerows on the land, and details of any to be retained, together with measures for their protection in the course of development, and details of numbers, species and proposed planting location of all new trees, shrubs and hedgerows.

Reason: To maintain and enhance visual amenity.

3. There shall be no storage of goods, containers, waste or other rubbish other than in an enclosed building or properly constructed refuse storage compound.

Reason: In the interests of amenity.

4. The development shall not be brought into use unless and until a new highway has been constructed along the route of Stoney Lane as provided for in the A41 London to Birmingham (Berkhamsted Bypass Side Roads) Order 1990.

Reason: To ensure that the proposed development does not prejudice the safe and free flow of trunk road traffic.

5. There shall be no direct vehicular or pedestrian access from the trunk road.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure that the proposed development does not prejudice the safe and free flow of trunk road traffic.

 A suitable fence shall be erected along the trunk road boundary, to the satisfaction of the Planning Authority, so as to prevent the straying of people or domestic animals.
