1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. This planning permission only relates to the installation of the 500 Series Valkyrie Heritage 'street light dome' camera for all four locations.

Reason: The 500 series non-Heritage Valkyrie dome is unacceptable as it will detract from the character and appearance of the Listed Buildings and Hemel Hempstead Conservation Area.

3. The permission hereby granted is an alternative to and not in addition to, either wholly or in part the following:

No part of the development referred to in this permission shall be carried out if any part of the development hereby permitted has been implemented.

Reason: In the interests of the character and appearance of the Listed Buildings and the Hemel Hempstead Conservation Area; a mix between the designs subject to Planning Permission 4/01890/97/BPA and 4/1661/99/BPA will be unacceptable.

4. The pillars, wall brackets and lantern housing shown coloured green on Plan No. 4/1661/99/BPA dated April 1999 shall be painted black at all times.

Reason: In the interests of the character and appearance of the listed buildings and the Hemel Hempstead Conservation Area.

5. The detailed location of the CCTV cameras at 14 Queensway, 51 High Street and 58 High Street and their associated cabling shall be agreed in writing by the local planning authority prior to the commencement of the installation of any of these cameras.

Reason: In the interests of the character and appearance of the Listed Buildings and Hemel Hempstead Conservation Area.
