1. The works for which this consent is granted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this consent.

Reason: To comply with section 18 of the Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

2. No works shall take place until details of the proposed means of fixing the stud walling to the internal structure of the building other than to any beams shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. The works shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details.

Reason: To safeguard the historic and architectural interest of the building.

3. The removal of the tongue and groove panelling to the second floor of the premises shall be carried out as carefully as possible so as to minimise any damage to the underlying plaster. Any damaged plaster shall be replaced with a lime based plaster, the exact composition of which shall first have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. The works shall be carried out in accordance with the details as approved.
