DEMOLITION OF ENTRANCE GATES, PIERS AND A WALL AT THE MEMORIAL GARDENS  
HIGH STREET, TRING

1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to refer to your Council's letter of 28 March 1988 enclosing an application for conservation area consent for the demolition of entrance gates, piers and a wall at the Memorial Gardens, High Street, Tring which are unlisted structures in a conservation area. The application was made in accordance with the provisions of Section 277A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 which was introduced into the Act by the Town and Country Amenities Act 1974 and the above Regulations.
2. The Secretary of State has considered the information submitted by your Council in support of their application. An officer of the Department has visited the site. Accordingly he hereby grants conservation area consent for the demolition of entrance gates, piers and a wall of Memorial Gardens, High Street, Tring subject to the condition that the demolition hereby permitted shall be begun not later than 5 years from the date of this consent.
3. This letter does not convey any consent or approval required under any enactment, bye-law, order or regulation other than Sections 55 and 56 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
