- 1. The works hereby permitted shall comprise only of the following:
- a) T1 Beech Reduce overhanging branches by a maximum of 4m making all cuts to a

suitable side branch or growing point.

b) T2 - Sycamore Fell

c) T3 - Horsechestnut Fell

Reasons:

- a) To improve light levels into the rear garden
- b) To reduce competition to T1
- c) The tree has extensive basal decay.
- 2. A replacement tree shall be planted for T3 in the planting season immediately following the removal of T3. It shall be of standard overall height (2.75m - 3m) planted as close as practically possible to the position of T3 and shall consist of one of the following: White beam, Rowan, Box elder or Hawthorn.

Reason: To compensate for the loss of the Horsechestnut and so maintain the visual amenity of the area.

3. The works hereby permitted shall commence within two years of the date of this decision and shall be carried out in accordance with BS 3998: 1989 "Recommendations for Tree Work".

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory standard of tree work.
