- 1. The site is within a rural area beyond the Green Belt on the adopted Dacorum District Plan wherein permission will only be given for use of land, the construction of new buildings, changes of use of existing buildings for agricultural or other essential purposes appropriate to a rural area or small scale facilities for participatory sport or recreation. No such need has been proven and the proposed development is unacceptable in the terms of this policy.
- The adopted Dacorum District Plan shows the site to be within the Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty wherein the policy of the local planning authority seeks to preserve the appearance of the area, encourage agriculture and conserve wildlife by the restriction of further development. The proposed development is unacceptable in the terms of this policy.
- 3. The proposal is not supported by evidence of local need sufficient to satisfy Policy 5 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan Deposit Draft.
- 4. The proposal would have a seriously detrimental effect on the general character and amenity of a designated Conservation Area which lies adjacent to the site.
- 5. The proposal would have a seriously detrimental effect on the flora and fauna of this site and the adjacent nature reserve, and would be contrary to the aims expressed in Policy 97 of the Dacorum Borough Local Plan Deposit Draft.
