REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/01726/97/OUT

- 1. The proposal would introduce a cramped form of development with insufficient amenity space into an attractive established spacious residential development. Policies of the Development Plan aim to safeguard the environment of the Borough including the residential areas and the proposed development would be in conflict with this aim.
- 2. The proposed development would have a detrimental impact on the Dawn Redwood tree located in the garden of 16 Branksome Close, which is the subject of a Tree Preservation Order. The proposed development would lead either to the loss of the tree or to pressure for extensive pruning which would significantly detract from the character and appearance of the area, contrary to the policies contained in the adopted Dacorum Borough Local Plan.
