1. The works for which this consent is granted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this consent.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with section 18 of the Planning (Listed Building and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

2. The replacement wall shall be constructed in reclaimed Bovingdon Multi Stock bricks using lime mortar, mixed in the proportions one part lime to three parts sharp well graded sand, with a tile creasing and brick on edge coping or such other materials and details as may be agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: To safeguard the character and appearance of the Listed Building.
