1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. There shall be no exterior lighting of the building or the application site except in accordance with details which shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority. Any exterior lighting shall be installed fully in accordance with the approved details and thereafter there shall be no changes to the approved details unless agreed in writing by the local planning authority.

Reason: In the interests of safeguarding the local environment and crime prevention, and to ensure control over the design and appearance of any fittings in the interests of preserving the architectural and historic interest of the listed building.
