1. Only the following works shall be carried out (All trees identified from plan provided)

a) Silver Birch - Prune to reduce over-extended branch from the house by 15 - 20 % ensuring all cuts are made to suitable branch junctions

b) Silver Fir - Thin upper crown by a maximum of 15% to include dead, diseased, crossing and damaged branches. Shorten over-extended lower limbs ensuring all cuts are made to suitable branch junctions

c) Red Oak (Tree viewed from house) - Remove lower branch growing towards the house back to the main trunk. Reduce in length the low lateral limb on the right hand side of the crown to a suitable branch junction. Thin and reduce the right hand side of the crown by a maximum of 15% ensuring as far as is possible the natural shape of the crown is maintained

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt and to ensure the public amenity value of the trees is maintained.

2. All works to be carried out in accordance with BS 3998 'Recommendations for Tree Work'

Reason: To ensure a satisfactory standard of tree work.
