- (a) for consent under section 10(b) of the Schedule to the Electric Lighting (Clauses) Act 1899 for the placing of electric lines above ground.

Proposed Electricity Supplies Langton Wood, Wigginton, Hertfordshire.

Eastern Electricity have been requested to provide three points of supply in the area of Langton Wood, Wigginton, Hertfordshire.

To provide these supplies it is proposed to erect three wood pole mounted transformers fed by underground cables at points shown positions A1, B and E on enclosed drawing number HA2/14906/MP Issue A subject to a reasonable deviation as may be found necessary, such deviation not to exceed 25 metres in the case of 11kV lines.

For the Council's information position 'E' pole mounted transformer is the amended position for an application made under their reference 4/0879/89/SU, the transformer being fed by underground cables NOT overhead lines.
