
CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/02060/98/FHA

1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The north west side of the conservatory shown coloured yellow on the approved drawings (Scale 1:100) shall be fitted at all times with Pilkington Cotswold type obscure glazing, in accordance with the manufacturer's details a copy of which was received by the local planning authority on 1 February 1999, and in accordance with the sample of glazing received by the local planning authority on 1 February 1999. All the windows within the area shown coloured yellow shall be permanently of a fixed type, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the local planning authority.



3. Notwithstanding the details specified on the approved drawings (Scale 1:100), Pilkington Florielle obscured glazing shall not be used anywhere within those parts of the conservatory shown coloured yellow on this plan.

<u>Reason</u>: The use of Pilkington Florielle obscured glazing would not provide adequate privacy (see the reason for condition 2) and for the avoidance of doubt.

4. The bricks to be used in the construction of the walls of the conservatory hereby permitted shall match in size, colour and texture those used on the existing building.
