## REASONS FOR REFUSAL APPLICABLE TO APPLICATION: 4/02109/98/FHA

Date of Decision: 27 January 1999

- 1. The building on the application site is a Grade II Listed Building and is within the Northchurch Conservation Area. By reason of its scale, form, siting and external appearance, the proposed conservatory would appear inappropriate and unsympathetic to the character and appearance of the listed building to which it would be attached, as well as failing to preserve or enhance the character of the Conservation Area.
- 2. The proposal fails to demonstrate that an adequate parking and turning area can be maintained within the site.
