1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. The development hereby permitted shall only be used for the purposes of agriculture as defined in section 336(1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

Reason: For the avoidance of doubt.

3. If the use of the building for the purposes of agriculture permanently ceases within ten years from the date on which the development was substantially completed, the building shall be removed from the land and the land shall, so far as is practicable, be restored to its condition before the development took place, or to such condition as shall have been agreed in writing with the local planning authority.

<u>Reason</u>: The site is within an area of archaeological significance and a scheduled ancient monument, and the building is only acceptable to enable the agricultural use of the land for the grazing of sheep. Sheep grazing is mutually compatible with the maintenance and preservation of the ancient monument. Where there is no compatible use for the building its retention would be prejudicial to the preservation of the ancient monument.

4. No hard surfacing or access track shall be constructed on the land outlined in blue on the approved drawings.

<u>Reason</u>: In the interests of the protection of the scheduled ancient monument and for the avoidance of doubt.
