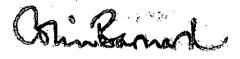

1. The development hereby permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

<u>Reason</u>: To comply with the requirements of Section 91 (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

2. Development shall be carried out in accordance with the revised materials submitted on 28.01.99.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development.

3. The development hereby permitted shall not be occupied until the arrangements for vehicle parking shown on the approved drawings shall have been provided, and they shall not be used thereafter otherwise than for the purposes approved.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure the adequate and satisfactory provision of off-street vehicle parking facilities.

4. The parking spaces shown numbered 6 and 7 on Drawing No. 440/S3/6AB shall be kept permanently available for use by visitors to Apple Cottages and Orchard Court.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure the adequate and satisfactory provision of off-street vehicle parking facilities.

5 All hard and soft landscape works shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details. The works shall be carried out prior to the occupation of either of the dwellings or in accordance with a programme which shall have been agreed in writing with the local planning authority.

<u>Reason</u>: To ensure a satisfactory appearance to the development and to safeguard the visual character of the immediate area.
