- fittle applicant inaggraved by the decision of the local planning authority to refuse parmasion or approval for the proposed development, or to grant parmission or approval subject to conditions, he may appeal to the Secretary of State for the Environment in accordance with section 36 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 within six months of receipt of this notice. (Appeals must be made on a form which is ubstantite from the Department of the Environment, Caston House, Yothill Street, London SWIH 9L23The Secretary of State has power to allow a longer period for the giving of a notice of appeal but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless these are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of appeal. The Secretary of State is not required to entertees an appeal if it appears to him that parmission for the proyocal development could not have been granted by the local planning authority, or could not have been garried otherwise than subject to the cenditions imposed by them, having regard to the statutory requirements (a), to the provisions of the development order, and to any directions given under the order. He does not in practice refuse to entertian appeals solely because the decision of the local planning authority was based on a direction given by kim.
