## Town and Country Planning Act, 1947 - Section 16 Appeal by Mr. T. C. Batcheler

- I am directed by the Minister of Heusing and Local Government to say that he has considered your client's appeal against the refusal of the Hemel Hempstead Borough Council, seting on behalf of Hertferdshire County Council to permit the erection of five detached bungalews on land adjoining 'Shanty Cafe", Lenden Read, Hemel Hempstead. He has considered the representations made in support of the appeal and the council's ebservations thereon. One of his officers has visited the site.
- The Minister sees no reason to differ from his decision given on your client's appeal last year in respect of a similar proposal for the development of the appeal site. As the site lies within the prepesed extension of the Metropolitan Green Belt he censiders that the Council are right in applying the green belt pelicy here and, except in very special circumstances, restricting development to that essential to the needs of agriculture or other rural purposes. He supports their view that prepend development would have the green belt and would raise traffic objections, even if the number of accesses on to the trunk read were limited to one. He has therefore decided to dismiss your elient's appeal. The Minister notes the Council's request for costs, but he has no power to make an order except in connection with a
